

Excerpt: . . . CHAPTER VIII ON THE GREEN At last we have reached the green; and it is now our business, as a general rule, to get our ball into the hole in two strokes more. An average of thirty-six putts per round of eighteen holes indicates satisfactory putting, though it is very hard in some cases to say whether certain strokes played from ten to twenty yards distance from the pin should be regarded as putts or chip-shots; according to the rules of golf, the ground within twenty yards of the hole, excepting hazards, is to be regarded as the putting green, though the shot might have to be played with the mashie or the niblick. Even if we choose to consider only those strokes played with the putter on the smooth turf surrounding the hole as putts, an average of two per hole throughout the round is seldom attained by the Second Division man, and indeed many golfers--otherwise really fine players--habitually fall short of this standard. In some cases the cause is to be found in a lack of confidence engendered by frequent failures due to a bad method of putting; in others the reason is simply that the player is too careless. He does not realise the importance of the stroke saved on the green, and will not take the trouble to examine the ground between his ball and the hole, to see what slopes there are, and whether the grass is stiff or...
